


Program: Our speaker was Normal Police Officer Brad Park and his partner, Officer Olive, a black lab and coon hound mix who is a facility dog or a wellness dog. Brad is community services officer at Normal PD.

As community services officer, he takes Olive to schools, assisted living centers and other places so Olive can make friends. The idea is to let members of the public have positive interactions with police so that when a more urgent police matter arises, the public will feel more comfortable in reaching out. Another of Olive's missions is to help police officers by offering a comfortable presence when the officers are under stress.

Olive is a sweet, non-aggressive dog and is not trained in the functions of what we might think of as a police dog. Olive was trained by a Peoria group that raises and trains service dogs. Olive and Brad had to go through extensive training.

Olive is Brad's dog, although the police department pays Olive's expenses. And Brad is Olive's human, and they spend nearly all day every day together. Olive wears a vest when she is on duty. When the vest comes off at home, Olive becomes a regular dog.
